The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, October 8, 2019 as advertised. Chairman Ritterbush called the meeting to order at 10:00 with Commissioners Nilson and Tuerk, Clerk Wentworth, Deputy Emergency Manager Wyrick. Ritterbush made reference to the open meetings act posted for the public.

Dan DeWitt and Dustin Holmen, site inspectors for FEMA met with the Commissioners briefly, before heading out to look at the road damage sites.

Ritterbush moved, Nilson seconded to approve the minutes as presented. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to accept the monthly reports for the Clerk, District Court Clerk and Treasurer as well as the quarterly reports for the Sheriff, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Tuerk moved to approve the mill levy for the village at 1.29918, for Dist. 100LN at .80277 and Dist. 100MN at .82502, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.
