The Keya Paha County Commissioners met on Tuesday, October 22, 2019 as advertised. At 9:00 am Vice Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order in the absence of Ritterbush, in the courtroom. County Government Day was being held, those present included: Commissioners Tuerk and Nilson, Treasurer Thiede, Deputy Treasurer Painter, Deputy Sheriff Kunze, Clerk/Assessor Wentworth, Clerk Magistrate Philben, Weed Supt. Mundorf, Instructor Ms. Walker and 10 students of the senior class. Introductions were given and a question and answer time was held. County Attorney Scott arrived after court and Zoning Adm Kienke was present in the meeting room.

After moving down to the meeting room, Nilson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—absent. Motion carried. Commissioners and Wyrick, deputy emergency manager discussed the disaster inventory list at length.

The commissioners and Wentworth went over the estimate cost damage for each location.
