Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:05 with Commissioners Nilson and Ritterbush and Clerk Wentworth present. County Attorney Scott arrived after court. Tuerk noted the open meetings act posted for the public.

After review, Ritterbush moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Nilson seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—abstain and Ritterbush—yes, motion carried.

The overhead doors on the road shop were discussed and tabled until the next meeting.

Discussion was held on the damage on River Road. T Wyrick, Deputy Emergency Manager updated the commissioners on the disaster work. Wyrick and Wentworth participated in a conference call with the PDMG from FEMA the previous week and Wyrick reported to the commissioners his conversations since the conference call with FEMA and stated that things are moving along.
