

The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, March 10, 2020 as advertised. Vice-Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order at 10:10 am with Ritterbush and Wentworth present, Tuerk was absent. Nilson noted the open meetings act posted for the public. The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed, Nilson moved to approve them as presented, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—absent and Ritterbush—yes. Motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to accept the monthly reports for the Treasurer, Clerk and District court Clerk, Nilson seconded. Voting: Tuerk—absent, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes, motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to accept the resignation of Doris Eichenberger and appoint Rachael Ferguson to the Library Board, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—absent, motion carried.

After review and a brief conference call with Caleb Johnson, Nilson moved to accept the letter of engagement for budget preparation for the 2020-2021 budget year, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—absent and Ritterbush—yes. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to set the 10 yard truck load rate at \$150 and the belly dump trailer rate at \$300, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—absent, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to adopt resolution 2020-02, making Keya Paha County a firearm friendly county, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—absent. Motion carried.
