The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, April 14, 2020 via Zoom Conference Call as advertised. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:03 with Nilson, L. Smith and Wentworth present, Ritterbush joined later. Several members of the public also listened in.

Nilson moved to approve the minutes of the March 17 emergency meeting and the regular conference call meeting held on the 24<sup>th</sup> of March, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—unavailable. Motion carried.

After review Nilson moved to approve the Clerk, District Court and Treasurers monthly reports along with the Sheriff's quarterly report, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—unavailable and Nilson—yes. Motion carried.

Under General Business, Tuerk reported that the detour route for Highway 12, began on Monday. Tuerk also reported that he had to close the river road towards Rock Barn because it had become impassable.

T Wyrick, deputy emergency manager, updated the commissioners on progress being made with FEMA and what documentation is needed.
