The Keya Paha County Commissioners met in the courtroom to observe social distancing requirements Thursday, May 14th 2020, as advertised. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:15 and noted that the open meetings act was posted for the public. Those present: Tuerk, Nilson, Ritterbush, L Smith and Wentworth.

After review, Nilson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Nilson—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson moved to approve the Clerk, District Court Clerk and Treasurers monthly reports, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

After review of the draft of the audit Ritterbush moved to approve the audit, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

After discussion Tuerk moved to continue with the courthouse closed to the public, Nilson seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. The Board elected to meet at the courthouse for the next commissioners meeting but will observe the health mandate of social distancing required.

Discussion was held on the Cub Creek project, Smith will begin the work of a hydrology study.
