

August 11, 2020

The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup> 2020 at the courthouse. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:00 am, noting the open meetings posted for the public. Those present include Commissioner Ritterbush, Clerk Wentworth, Hwy Supt. Smith and Co Attorney Scott. Commissioner Nilson was absent.

At 10:10 the commissioners held a conference call with Andy Forney, of D A Davidson on the bonding options that the county. The commissioners decided to issue bonds valued at \$3,000,000 with a maturity of 15 years. The bond proceeds will be utilized to support the ongoing damage repairs incurred in the March 2019 flooding. Forney will prepare the documents.

R Richey, West Plains Bank met with the commissioners for short term financing for use until the project with D A Davidson is complete. Ritterbush moved, Tuerk seconded to sign the interim financing for \$200,000. Voting: Nilson—absent, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. Motion carried.

L Smith presented the commissioners with new bids for the Leavens Bridge. Tuerk moved to award the Leavens Bridge project to Norfolk Contracting Inc for \$397,932.00, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—absent. Motion carried.

Spring Creek project was discussed, no action was taken.

902<sup>nd</sup> Road was discussed, it was decided to move forward with armor coating. AMZ was not necessary.

Carnes detour route funding was discussed.

The Commissioners took a lunch break.
