

September 8, 2020

The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, September 8, 2020 as advertised. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:00 am with Commissioners Nilson and Ritterbush present. Tuerk noted the open meetings act posted for the public. After review of the previous minutes Nilson moved and Ritterbush seconded to approve the minutes as presented. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Whitney Abbott, NCDHD reported on the alcohol and tobacco check results in Keya Paha County. Turbine Mart will receive recognition for the perfect record for the last three years. Abbott discussed LB840 which goes into effect November 14<sup>th</sup> which adds e-cigs and vapes to be prohibited where there is already no smoking mandated. Abbott also noted that beginning Oct 1<sup>st</sup> the legal age for purchasing tobacco will go to 21.

After review Nilson moved to accept the Clerk, District Court and Treasurers monthly reports, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

The Annual Certification was tabled until the next regular meeting.

The Road Superintendent was tabled until the next regular meeting.

The shop audit was tabled until the next regular meeting.

A short discussion was held on benefits available through NACO, VSP Vision is offered through NACO at nearly half of the rate through Aflac. A NACO representative will be contacting the Clerk's office.

The Commissioners went to lunch.
