A Cook met with the commissioner via zoom to discuss equipment and presented them with quotes. Commissioners agreed with A. Cook that the equipment needed fixed and approved A. Cook to start the work.

T. Wyrick joined the meeting by zoom and updated the commissioners on FEMA progress and what is still needed from each district.
