

January 26, 2021

The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, January 26, 2021 as advertised. Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. with Commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush, County Attorney Scott and Clerk Wentworth present. Nilson referenced the open meetings act posted for the public. After review, Nilson moved to approve the minutes as presented, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

After discussion, Nilson moved to adopt the fuel card policy and to distribute the fuel cards to employees after they sign the agreement on use of the cards by employees, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to adopt Resolution 21-01 allowing L. Smith to prepare a report on the Road Abandonment as described in Resolution 21-02, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Tuerk moved, Nilson seconded to adopt Resolution 21-02 setting the hearing to the road abandonment for March 9, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. at the courthouse. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to adopt Resolution 21-03 allowing the signing of the Year End Certification of the Highway Superintendent, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

The commissioners and Scott took a break for lunch.

T. Wyrick, Deputy Emergency Manager met with the Commissioners to update them on FEMA projects that he working with our FEMA representative on. Wyrick needed GPS coordinates from Ritterbush.

Ritterbush moved, Nilson seconded to authorize the chairman to sign the additional rip rap proposal for Leavens Bridge from Norfolk Contracting. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.
