

February 9, 2021

The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, February 9<sup>th</sup> 2021 as advertised. Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order at 10:10 a.m. with commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush, L. Smith and Clerk Wentworth present. Nilson noted the open meetings act posted for the public.

After review, Nilson moved, Tuerk seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson moved to approve the monthly reports for the Clerk, Treasurer and the District Court Clerk, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

L. Sawle, M. Sawle and K. Galas were in the discuss LB 236 with the commissioners. The commissioners will look into adopting a resolution and but the topic on the agenda for the next meeting.

Nilson moved to open the 1-6 Year Road Hearing at 11:00 a.m., Tuerk seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried. No one from the public attended. At 11:30 Tuerk moved to come out of the 1-6 Year Road hearing, Nilson seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried. Tuerk moved to approve the 1-6 Year Road Plan and adopt resolution 21-07. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

The commissioners talked to the road crew about the billing on the Leavens Bridge.

Ritterbush moved to adopt Resolution 21-06, transferring \$600,000 that was borrowed for the emergency road fund back into the inheritance fund, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on the E911 Surcharge that is collected in Keya Paha County.

The commissioners took a lunch break.

T. Wyrick met with the commissioners to update them on the various FEMA projects and what FEMA is requesting on the different projects, including an archeology study at the Leavens Bridge.

Discussion was held on Region 24 and what the future is for Keya Paha county to continue being a part of the region. Brown and Cherry counties have set dates that they will remove themselves The commissioners asked the county attorney to set up a joint meeting with the commissioners of all the counties that are included in Region 24 right now.
