The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, March 9th 2021 as advertised. Chairman Nilson call the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with Commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush, L. Smith and Clerk Wentworth present. Nilson noted the open meetings act posted for the public.

Nilson moved , Tuerk seconded to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented. voting Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to accept the Treasurer, Clerk and district Court Clerk's monthly reports, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson moved to accept the letter of engagement for Budget prep for the budget years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 with Caleb Johnson of J13 Enterprises, LLC, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to open the road abandonment hearing at 11:00, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried. L. Smith recommended abandonment of both sections of the road advertised. The commissioners listened to concerns from the public.

At 11:20 Nilson moved to close the hearing, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried. Tuerk moved to honor the request for road closure from W. Lawrence, contingent upon approval from the Co. Attorney and sign the resolution stating so, seconded by Nilson. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

T. Wyrick met with the commissioners to give them a FEMA update.

D. Fox was present and the commissioners discussed the charge for mitigation for Keya Paha County, it was decided that the mitigation cost for the village should be paid by the village, the fee will be \$2,000 for the county and \$1,000 for the village.
