

May 11, 2021

The Keya Paha County commissioners met Tuesday, May 11, 2021 as advertised. Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. with commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush and Clerk Wentworth present. Nilson noted the open meetings act posted for the public.

After review, Nilson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to accept the Treasurer, Clerk and District Court Clerk's monthly reports, Nilson seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson made a motion to authorize the Treasurers office to create a fund for the American Rescue Plan dollars the county will receive, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Tuerk moved to adopt Resolution 21-11 which states effective June 30, 2021 Keya Paha County will withdraw from Region 24, Nilson seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

At 11:00 the commissioners had a zoom session with the Cherry County commissioners to discuss the possibility of Keya Paha County joining Cherry county for emergency management. Each county will research and bring numbers to the next meeting to be discussed again.

The commissioners went to lunch.

T. Mundorf and J. Orton, historical society committee members were present to report that the committee voted to renovate the building and are moving forward with the goal to have the new roof by fall. They were asking for the county to back them on the roof costs, it was estimated they have approximately half the funding needed for the roof at this point and have a fund raiser scheduled for Memorial Day weekend. The commissioners said that they can count on the county for some help, but they will wait to see what is needed, and at a later time set a dollar amount. The commissioners advised them to move forward with estimates and scheduling the roof repair.

The commissioners discussed the Blue Cross Blue Shield renewal and decided to stay with the \$500 deductible.

Nilson moved to approve tax correction 387, for duplicate personal property, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Mike Boden, NACO Benefit Service Manager met with the commissioners to introduce himself, he just started with NACO in February. The commissioners asked him to get them more info on the disability that is offered through NACO.
