The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday; June 22nd 2021 as advertised. Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order with Commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush and Clerk Wentworth present. Nilson referenced the open meetings act posted for the public.

After review Nilson moved to approve the minutes as presented, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

T. Wyrick, deputy emergency manager met with the commissioners to update them on the FEMA projects that are still pending. Wyrick reported that the disaster has met a new threshold and will now be in a 90/10 split with the county portion of the expenses now being just 10%, retroactively.

K. Theide and A. Painter presented a resolution, after discussion Nilson moved to adopt the Public Agency Investment Trust Resolution, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Tuerk moved to have Kaye Thiede and AnneJeanette Painter with the Treasurer's office open and be named authorized signors for the required American Rescue Plan Act account for the funds that are being sent to the county, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried

The Treasures office also presented a copy of the new pledged securities to the commissioners.

Tuerk moved to authorize the chairman to sign the representation letter from the auditors, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

The commissioners went to lunch.
