The Keya Paha County Commissioner met on Tuesday, July 13th 2021 as advertised. Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order at 10:05 with Commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush and Clerk Wentworth present. Nilson noted the open meetings act posted on the wall. After review Ritterbush moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as presented, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson moved accept the Clerk, district Court Clerk and Treasurers monthly reports and the Sheriff's quarterly report, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

T. Wyrick updated the commissioners on FEMA project progress.

C. Plate, BKR Extension presented the commissioners with the extension office budget. Nilson moved, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Keya Paha Historical Society board members J. Orton, T. Mundorf and J. Ripley met with the commissioners to update them on the fundraising progress and planned work on the roof. Ritterbush moved to make a one time payment of \$30,000 out of the Inheritance Fund to the Historical Society to help with the expense of the roof. A sinking fund was discussed and the commissioners suggested that the historical society board create a budget to present to the commissioners at the next meeting.

The commissioners went to lunch.

T. Ripley met with the commissioners to request a donation to the community fireworks. Nilson moved to make a \$200 donation in the claims in the next meeting, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

J. Vaisvilas and J Prewitt with KBR Power presented a Request to Occupy ROA Application for a buried power line. Ritterbush moved to approve the application, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.
