Treasurer Thiede and Deputy Treasurer Painter came in and discussed the SLFRF, the American Rescue Act, the appointment of a committee and the responsibilities that the committee needs to do. As of now, they are still working on getting information on how the money can be spent. Until we know how the money can be spent the commissioners will leave Treasurer Thiede the representative.

Resolution KP 21-17 allowable Increase of Restricted Funds (1%) was presented to the Commissioners, Tuerk moved to approve Resolution KP 21-17, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush-yes, Nilson-yes and Tuerk-yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to approve Resolution KP 21-18, Authorization/Reauthorization of Petty Cash Funds, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson-yes, Tuerk-yes and Ritterbush-yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to approve Resolution KP 21-19, Tax Allocation to the Miscellaneous Districts, Nilson moved to approve KP 21-19, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk-yes, Ritterbush-yes and Nilson-yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioners discussed different options, styles, and prices on tanker trucks. Commissioners are going to continue to look and will decide at a later date when some options are found.
