The Keya Paha County Commissioners met in a special session Tuesday, September 14<sup>th</sup> 2021 at the Keya Paha County Courthouse meeting room with the purpose of adopting the budget and setting the final tax request as advertised in the September 8<sup>th</sup> 2021 edition of the Springview Herald. Chairman Nilson called the meeting to order at 2:47 p.m. with Commissioners Tuerk and Ritterbush and Clerk Wentworth also present. Nilson referenced the open meetings act posted for the public. There were no members of the public present.

After review of Property Tax Request Resolution 2021-20, which sets the 2021/2022 property tax request for the General Fund be set at \$778,078.19 and the Road Bond Fund be set at \$178,893.08 which is a decrease from the 2020/2021 tax request, Nilson noted the county's proposed operating budget is decreasing by 16.95%. Nilson moved to adopt the Tax Request Resolution 21-20, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Tuerk moved to adopt Resolution 21-21 Keya Paha County 2021/2022 Budget Document Resolution of Adoption and Appropriations, Ritterbush seconded Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Ritterbush moved to adopt Resolution 21-22 Transfer of Funds from county General Fund to the Road/Bridge Fund, Nilson seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

At 2:50 p.m. Ritterbush moved to adjourn the special meeting, Nilson seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.
