The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, February 8th 2022 at the Keya Paha county courthouse. Chairman Ritterbush called the meeting to order at 10:08 a.m. with commissioners Nilson and Tuerk, Clerk Wentworth and L. Smith present. Ritterbush noted the open meetings act posted for the public.

Nilson move to approve the minutes of the previous meeting, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

After review, Nilson moved to accept the Clerk, District Court Clerk and Treasurers monthly reports, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes., all voted in favor. Motion carried.

H Hespe met with the Commissioners to discuss the information on ambulances. The board will have the county attorney create a bid proposal with the specifications on it and Hespe will gather vendors to send the formal bid request to.

At 11:00 a.m. Nilson moved to open the 1-6 Year Road Hearing, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Smith presented the map of the road projects for the 1-6 year plan and discussion was held on the various projects.

Tuerk moved, Nilson seconded to close the hearing at 11:30 a.m. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Tuerk moved to approve the 1-6 Road Plan as adjusted, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

The commissioners went to lunch.

The commissioners participated in a conference call with representatives from First Net, they will be contacting the sheriff to move forward.

T. Wyrick met with the commissioners to update them on the process with FEMA, Lloyd Smith will be getting information to Tim to turn in to FEMA.

Robert Connot met with the commissioners to discuss a road closing that had previously taken place.

Nilson moved to have the chairman sign the memorandum of understanding with the NE Dept. of Veteran's Affairs, Tuerk seconding. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.
