The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, March 8<sup>th</sup> 2022 as advertised. Chairman Ritterbush called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with commissioners Nilson and Tuerk, Clerk Wentworth and L. Smith present. Ritterbush noted the open meetings policy posted for the public.

The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed, Tuerk moved to approve the minutes as presented, Nilson seconded. Roll call: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Nilson moved to accept the Clerk, district Court Clerk and Treasurers monthly reports, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Smith discussed some road closures with the commissioners.

At 10:15 the commissioners discussed the counties bulk fuel storage with State Fire Marshal Brent Lakin and KC Pawling with NIRMA. After a short discussion they all went to the sites. After returning from viewing the commissioners are waiting for an estimate from Kelly Stenka at CVA. No decisions made or actions taken.

The commissioners took a break for lunch.

Nilson moved, Ritterbush seconded to approve the annual liquor license for the Keya Paha County Ag Society. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Zoning Admin. Kienke met with the commissioners to tell them that the conditional use hearing scheduled and advertised for this time has been rescheduled for a later time due to lack of a quorum of the planning committee.
