The Keya Paha County commissioners met Tuesday, April 26, 2002 as advertised. Chairman Ritterbush called the meeting to order at 10:15 a.m. and noted the open meetings act posted for the public. Present at the meeting were Commissioners Nilson and Tuerk, County Attorney Scott and Clerk Wentworth.

After review Ritterbush moved to approve the minutes as presented, Nilson seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Ritterbush—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

The assist grant was tabled until a later time.

The commissioners tabled the time and attendance app indefinitely.

The subdivision agenda item was tabled until after lunch.

K. Mizner presented his annual reports to the commissioners to keep them updated on the weed department.

The Commissioners and Scott took a break for lunch.

Those present to discuss the Carns Bridge project were Highway Supt. Smith and Rock County Commissioners J. Stout, W. Hollenbeck and G. Mays and G. Steele with Miller and Associates. Information and plans were presented on a new bridge structure to replace the damaged Carns Bridge. Both proposals include hard armor, one proposal is for 950 ft bridge and the second proposal is for an 1100 ft. bridge. The change in the river current and bank stabilization was discussed at length. J. Stout made a motion to move forward with the 950 ft. bridge proposal, M. Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—yes, J Stout—yes, W. Hollenbeck—yes and G. Mays—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson left the meeting.

Tuerk moved to approve the section subdivision from the 11 o'clock agenda item, Ritterbush seconded. Voting: Ritterbush—yes, Nilson—absent and Tuerk—yes. Motion carried.
