The Keya Paha Commissioners met Tuesday, March 28th 2023 as advertised. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:05 and referenced the open meetings act that is posted for the public. Nilson, Frederick, E. Kinney, E. Scott and L. Smith were present. The minutes of the previous meeting were reviewed. Nilson moved, Frederick seconded to approve the minutes as presented. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Frederick—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

B. Kienke talked to the commissioners regarding a Special Designated liquor license permit, after discussion E. Scott would look more into the permit.

T. Wyrick stopped by to give updates. The FCC is a 10 year renewal, he was able to get it taken care of before it lapsed. CBDG is moving along. They are requesting a timeline, he is working on getting it done and turned in.

L. Smith presented a map from the state regarding private drives. Smith is going to do more research on what it's all about and the reasoning behind it since not all private drives are on the map.

Commissioners reviewed the 7 applications that were turned in for the Supervisor position for the Road Department. After some conversations interviews will be scheduled in the afternoon on April 11th. Clerk's office will contact the applicants to set up the times.

The commissioners and E. Scott took a lunch break.

The county handbook was discussed after talking with E. Scott, commissioners tabled until the next regular meeting.

D. Kienke and Kristin Olson with NCDC came to give an update on NCDC. They are working on a housing development grant that will be for the Tri County area and wanted to let the commissioners know how it's going and what the process for our county is going to be.
