

April 11, 2023

The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday, April 11th, 2023, as advertised. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. with C. Nilson, J. Frederick, B. Crawford and S. Wentworth present. Tuerk referenced the open meetings act posted for the public.

Crawford met with the commissioners to discuss the need for a bagger for the current county owned lawn mower at the courthouse. Frederick moved to have Crawford work with Springview Implement to order the appropriate bagger attachment for the mower, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Frederick—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

After review, Nilson moved to approve the minutes of the previous meeting, Tuerk seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Frederick—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Tuerk moved, Frederick seconded to approve the monthly reports for the Clerk, District Court Clerk, and Treasurer and also the quarterly report for the sheriff's dept. Frederick seconded. Voting: Frederick—yes, Nilson—yes and Tuerk—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Under General Business the board discussed a bill the county received for snow removal; no action was taken.

Tuerk moved to approve a Special Designated Liquor License from Bryan & JoJo Kienke that was tabled at the last meeting, Frederick seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes and Frederick—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Nilson made a motion to authorize the chairman to sign all eleven of the CBDG grant applications, Frederick seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Frederick—yes and Nilson—yes, all voted in favor. Motion carried.

Discussion on the county employee handbook update was tabled until a later meeting.

The Commissioners took a lunch break.

The Commissioners interviewed applicants for the open road supervisor position. The commissioners will conduct follow up interviews at the next regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday April 25th.
