The Keya Paha County Commissioners met Tuesday as advertised. Chairman Tuerk called the meeting order at 10:05 a.m. with Commissioners Nilson, Frederick and Deputy Clerk Kinney present. Tuerk referenced the open meetings act posted for the public. After review Nilson moved to approve the minutes as presented, Frederick seconded. Voting: Nilson—yes, Tuerk—yes, and Frederick—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

During general business, trees in right of ways and complaints on mowing ditches were discussed. Talked with Eric Scott regarding who's responsibility it is to maintain all, and Eric agreed that it is the landowner's responsibility for maintaining.

Commissioners reviewed July's monthly reports. After review, Frederick moved to accept the Clerk, District Court and Treasurers monthly reports, Nilson seconded. Voting: Tuerk—yes, Frederick—yes and Nilson—yes. All voted in favor, motion carried.

Deputy Clerk informed Commissioners that Mindy Spencer with Miles of Smiles needed to reschedule and will now be coming in September to visit with them.

A. Painter let the Commissioners know that more opioid funds came in. Commissioners decided since this is an ongoing thing that they would like to discuss at the next meeting with Eric Scott regarding an open-ended resolution.

NCDC's representative K. Olson came and give an update regarding the housing study for our county and to inform the Commissioners that some grants available for any projects or equipment that the county might need. Discussion was had on some new equipment, and they will be in contact with her regarding some ideas.

T. Wyrick presented a FEMA closeout amount, Commissioners agreed that it looked like a good settlement and T. Wyrick said he will let FEMA know we accept. T. Wyrick said he just got back from training and received lots of good information and will be working with Matt Sandoz on some things.

The Commissioners went to lunch.

J. Cook, road supervisor, met with the Commissioners. They reviewed a quote regarding the culvert on Gregory Ave that had come in. J. Cook is going to get another quote to compare prices before a decision is made. Discussion regarding some equipment repairs that need to be done and possibly utilizing the grants K. Olson informed the Commissioners about for newer equipment.
